## Signs/Symptoms

Your dancer is showing signs & symptoms of Covid-19.

### Contact Us

See contact info above

### Positive Test

Dancer was tested for Covid-19 & had positive test results.

### Quarantine

Dancer should follow the CDC guidelines & remain home for 10 days.

### Back to the Studio

Dancer can return to the studio as soon as 10 days after symptoms first appeared given that they are no longer showing symptoms or 10 days from date that they tested positive if they are not showing symptoms.

## Positive Test

Your dancer or a close contact has tested positive for Covid-19.

### Dancer

Your dancer tested positive for Covid-19.

### Contact Us

### Quarantine

If your dancer has tested positive for Covid-19, they should follow guidelines from the CDC & the local health department which would include isolating for 10 days after symptoms first appeared or from date that they tested positive if they are not showing symptoms.

### Contacts Notified

Anyone who is considered a close contact will be notified of possible exposure to Covid-19.

### Thorough Clean

The studio area(s) used by the dancer will get a thorough cleaning.

### Zoom

Your dancer will have the option to continue participating in class over Zoom. Please contact the studio to let us know if this is something they are interested in.

### Close Contact

A close contact of your dancer has tested positive.

### Quarantine

If a close contact has tested positive for Covid-19, your dancer should follow guidelines from the CDC & the local health department which would include staying home & monitoring themselves for symptoms for 14-days.

### Zoom

Your dancer will have the option to continue participating in class over Zoom. Please contact the studio to let us know if this is something they are interested in.

### Back to the Studio

Dancer can return to the studio as soon as 14 days after coming in contact with a positive case, given that they never developed symptoms.
